Please follow guidance from CDC and local health authorities to minimize the spread of viruses. The steps that you should take include:

- Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly for at least 20 seconds.
- Sanitize hands regularly throughout the day.
- Let MAGIC or venue staff know if you feel unwell or start experiencing symptoms.
